

Experience Córdoba Daily itinerary

Cost per person: \$3,850 (Double Occupancy)/\$4,700 (Single Occupancy)

Day 0 -- Travel Day

Day 1 -- Madrid

Check-in time at our hotel is 3pm and then we will gather for cocktails at 5pm before making our way to an early dinner. Meals included: Cocktails and Dinner

Day 2 -- Madrid/Córdoba

After breakfast at the hotel, we'll catch the AVE, Spain's high-speed train, to Córdoba. Upon arrival, we'll check into our hotel and enjoy an afternoon tour of the stunning <u>Mezquita</u>. Later, indulge in a private wine-pairing dinner with one of Andalucía's leading sommeliers. Meals included: Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner

Day 3-- Córdoba

This is our wine and oil day. We will board a bus for a 45-minute ride to the town of Montilla to visit an olive mill to see how olives are processed into extra virgin olive oil followed by a tasting. Next, we'll travel to Moriles to visit the <u>Bodegas El Monte winery</u>. We'll have a tour that will include a tasting of their wines, a ride through their vineyards and a tapas lunch. Back in Córdoba, we'll have no scheduled activities. Meals included: Breakfast and Lunch

Day 4 -- Córdoba

The theme for this day is "pig on the hoof and pig on the plate." We will board a bus for a 90-minute ride to the town of Villanueva de Córdoba. In Villenueva, we'll visit a dehesa where Iberian pigs are raised in a free-range environment. We will then visit the <u>Ibesa</u> facility where Jamon Iberico is aged for a tour and tasting. For lunch we will go to a restaurant for a pork-centric lunch from a woodfired grill. After lunch, we'll return to Córdoba. No group activities are planned for the evening. Meals included: Breakfast and Lunch

Day 5 -- Córdoba

We will have a guided tour of patios in the San Basilio neighborhood followed by a free afternoon to explore Córdoba on your own. In the evening, we'll meet our hosts for a tapas tour of four unique bars. Meals included: Breakfast and Dinner

Day 6 - Córdoba/Madrid

On our last day in Córdoba, we'll will have a mid-morning visit to the <u>Palace of the Christian Monarchs</u>. After the tour, we will be on our own for one last bit of shopping and lunch before catching our 337pm train to Madrid. Back in Madrid, we'll check into our hotel and have some free time before a tapas tour of the old city of Madrid. Meals included: Breakfast and Dinner

Day 7 — Madrid/Segovia

After a fairly early breakfast in the hotel, we'll make our way to the Chamartín train station to catch the train to Segovia. During our 8-hour visit to Segovia, we'll visit the <u>Alcázar de Segovia</u>, the Roman Aqueduct and the Cathedral. We'll have plenty of time for a leisurely lunch and shopping and exploring before catching a late-afternoon train back to Madrid. We will have a free evening in Madrid. Meals included: Breakfast and Lunch

Day 8 – Madrid

After a morning tour of the <u>Prado Museum</u>, you will have the afternoon free for lunch and exploring. We'll gather for our farewell dinner in the evening. Meals included: Breakfast and Dinner

Day 9 – Madrid

The tour ends after breakfast in the hotel. Meals included: Breakfast
